The winning entries will be announced on the day.



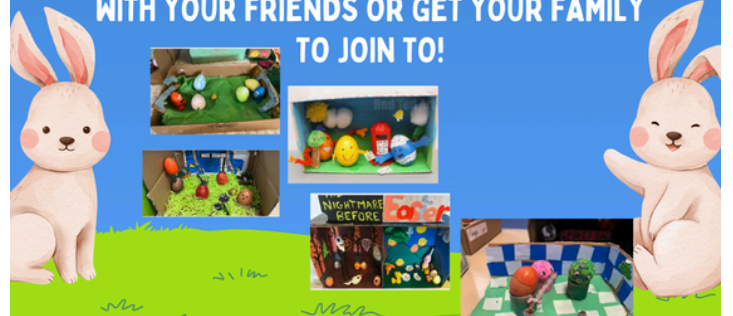
